

Dear Campers, Parents, and Caregivers,

Summer is almost here and you know what that means....**RANCH CAMP 2019!** I just wanted to remind you of a few things, provide you with a list of things to bring, and also a map. This is very important information!

## **Medical**

The following regulations are established by the Texas Department of Health and we **MUST** abide by them.

- Prescription medications that come to camp must be dispensed out of their **original containers**.
- If a camper takes an over the counter medication (OTC) (for example Claritin, Benadryl, Advil) on a regular schedule, we **MUST** have written doctor's orders in order to dispense that medication to your camper.
- We can only dispense according to the directions on the prescription container. If you are giving more or less than the amount prescribed, we **MUST** have a written prescription indicating the change from your camper's doctor.
- **Please fill out the MAR sheet that is attached with this email. We cannot accept campers if enough medication has not been brought for the week of camp.** If your camper is coming more than one week, you will need to fill out a MAR Sheet for each week they are attending.

## **Drop-Off and Pick-Up**

- Drop-off is on Sunday afternoon at **5pm**. We will not begin checking campers in until 5pm. Please allow up to 45 minutes for check-in.
- Dinner will be served on Sunday to all campers.
- Closing ceremonies is at **10am** on Friday. We encourage all to attend, the campers love for you to meet their new friends and share their experience.
- Additional fees will be charged and may jeopardize future admission for any campers picked up after **1pm**.

## **Camp Theme**

This year we have a different theme for each day. Please see your packing list to find what those themes are. I know your camper is anxious to know what team color they are on.

## **Lost and Found**

Down Home Ranch will hold Lost and Found items for one month after camp. If items are not claimed at that time, they will be donated to a charity. Parents and/or campers are responsible for the shipping fee of Lost and Found items.
